

Ride on the highest, steepest, waterpowered funicular railway in the world! Lynton & Lynmouth Cliff Railway

This incredible Victorian invention opened in 1890, joining the two villages of Lynton & Lynmouth, some 500ft (150m) apart. Two cars are joined by a continuous steel cable and ascend and descend on the principle of balance.

At the top, each car is filled with 700 gallons of water which then provides the weight to pull the other car up as it descends. It's as simple as that, and the views are simply breathtaking.



While visiting Lynton and Lynmouth be sure to pay a visit to the fascinating and varying mix of shops, pubs and eating places.

Lynton's shops and places to eat are a short walk from the town's ample car parks and a gentle stroll from the Cliff Railway.


